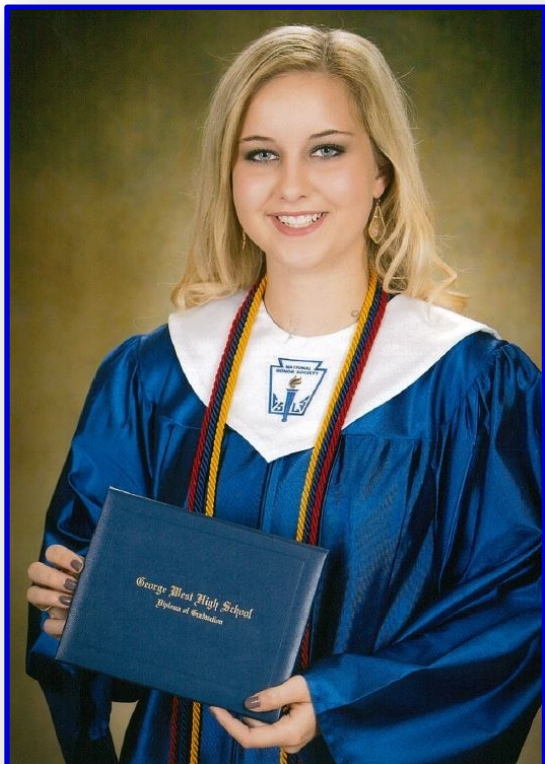

Hannah participated in several extra-curricular activities while in high school including UIL academic competitions in Number Sense, Mathematics and Science where she regularly placed at regionals and advanced to the state competitions. Hannah has also participated in BPA. She is currently the president and advanced to the Business Professionals of America National Contest as a junior where she finished 7<sup>th</sup> in Fundamental Spreadsheet Applications.

The library will also be open for any student to check out books and continue reading over the summer. The computer lab will be open for testing. Prizes will be given for high point summer readers.

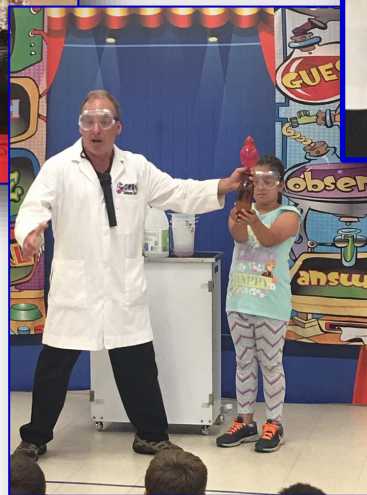
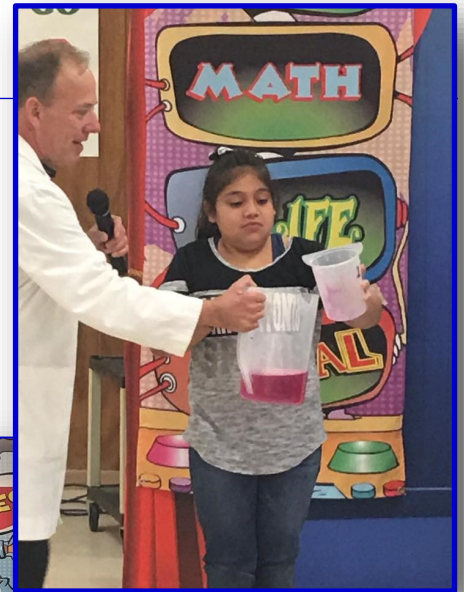
